## Catholic-Jewish Relations in Buenos Aires - The City of Pope Francis

It was Cardinal Bergoglio, Archbishop of Buenos Aires and the future Pope Francis, who wished Fr. Daniel Cutri for further biblical studies in Jerusalem. Fr. Daniel's theological education has been immensely shaped by the practical consequences of *Nostra Aetate* in the capital of his native Argentina. The lecture will present the development of this Catholic Christian Bible post graduate student of Biblical Sciences and Archeology, in the context of the new teaching of the Roman Catholic Church on Jews and Judaism. The investigation explores that object of education like a substance in a laboratory, not knowing whether it is explosive or stable, whether it blows the mind or extends the perception. The lecturer subjects *Nostra Aetate* to the test of his remarkable combination of experience, personal history, knowledge of Judaism and cherished familiarity with Archbishop Bergoglio and his approach to Judaism and the Jewish people. As a preparation for the lecture, Fr. Daniel recommends the reading of two sermons by Cardinal Bergoglio which he has translated into English (see attachments).
