The Fraternity is honored to present a lecture by Dr. Gershon Nerel who will review modern JYB-studies in Israel. Following the works of Shlomo Pines and David Flusser on Jesus, academic research on gentile believers and JYB developed a variety of modern conceptual approaches which contributed, collectively, as an initial component to the Hebrew University's *Center for the Study of Christianity* in the year 2000. This lecture will examine two decades of JYB-studies at the Hebrew University followed by research interests at international academic conferences causing revisions of traditional readings of JYB.

A historian of the modern movement of JYB Dr. Nerel documented JYB for the period 1917-67 in his doctoral dissertation (1996, Hebrew University) and is currently investigating theological and liturgical aspects of such factions since the time of the Renaissance. Together with his wife Sara, Dr. Nerel revised the Franz Delitzsch Hebrew translation of the New Testament (Beer Sheva, 2003).
