Aaron Lipkin is an Israeli Bible scholar who specializes in biblical archaeology of Israel and lectures in many churches, synagogues, university classes, TV, and radio stations. Aaron is also a film maker and has created several videos that incorporate Biblical text, Archaeology, the geography of Israel and stunning drone videos. He is a member of the Manasseh hill Country Survey team founded by Prof. Adam Zeral of the Haifa University.

His lecture presents the material remains, inscriptional evidence, and historical analysis making interconnections with the book of Joshua. This is a rare opportunity to learn archaeology with fresh perspectives from theology and the Bible.

The discovery of this altar has been a startling and riveting experience. Aaron gives you the factual evidence, the setting in life, and the cultural application which will make you feel like you are there with him on location in Israel.
