Professor Schiffman is a specialist in the Dead Sea Scrolls, Judaism in late antiquity, the history of Jewish law, and Talmudic literature. His many publications include *From Text to Tradition: A History of Second Temple and Rabbinic Judaism*; *Reclaiming the Dead Sea Scrolls*; *Qumran and Jerusalem: Studies in the Dead Sea Scrolls and the History of Judaism*; *The Temple Scroll* (with A.D. Gross); and more than 200 articles on the Dead Sea Scrolls and Rabbinic Judaism. He coedited the *Encyclopedia of the Dead Sea Scrolls* and the award-winning *Outside the Bible: Ancient Jewish Writings Related to Scripture*, and the five-volume series, *An End to Antisemitism*. He is also a highly respected and frequent guest lecturer at the Ecumenical Theological Research Fraternity in Israel.

I am looking forward to this presentation which will highlight the life and the rich legacy of Prof. Adam Zertal as well as connect the physical archaeological remains and the geographical setting of the land with the Bible. Aaron gives you the factual evidence, the setting in life, and the cultural application which makes you feel like you are with him there on location in Israel.
