18 September 1960 at the Vatican, a subcommittee of the Secretariat for the Christian Unity under Cardinal Augustin Bea was established with the task to prepare a draft text regarding the *Quaestiones de Judaeis* (Regarding the Jewish People) in preparation for a statement of the Second Vatican Council. Leo von Rudloff, O.S.B., was a member of that drafting committee, together with Iohannes Oesterreicher, Gregorius Baum, O.S.A., and Georgius Tavard, A.A. The commissioners went through a long and arduous process before that text version was published now known as the fourth chapter of Nostra Aetate of 28 October 1965. The history of the difficulties of the declaration has been recognized; the nature of the obstacles has hardly been theological. P Ralph Greis will give fresh insights into Abbot Rudloff's responsibilities and into the work that enhanced Nostra Aetate.
